## **C-377 Returns to the Senate this fall.**

(Surrey) - Member of Parliament Russ Hiebert says he's pleased with the Prime Minister's recent announcement that Parliament will be prorogued in advance of the fall Parliamentary sitting.

"Prorogation means my Private Members Bill C-377, regarding financial transparency for labour organizations, will return to the Senate for First Reading in the form it was passed by the House of Commons on December 12, of 2012," said Mr. Hiebert. "As such, I am hopeful that my colleagues in the Senate will give C-377 appropriate and timely consideration."

Mr. Hiebert noted that amendments made by the Senate in June to radically reduce the scope and impact of C-377 will be discarded as a result of prorogation, and the bill to be considered by the Senate in the fall will once again reflect the wishes of the elected lower house of Parliament.
